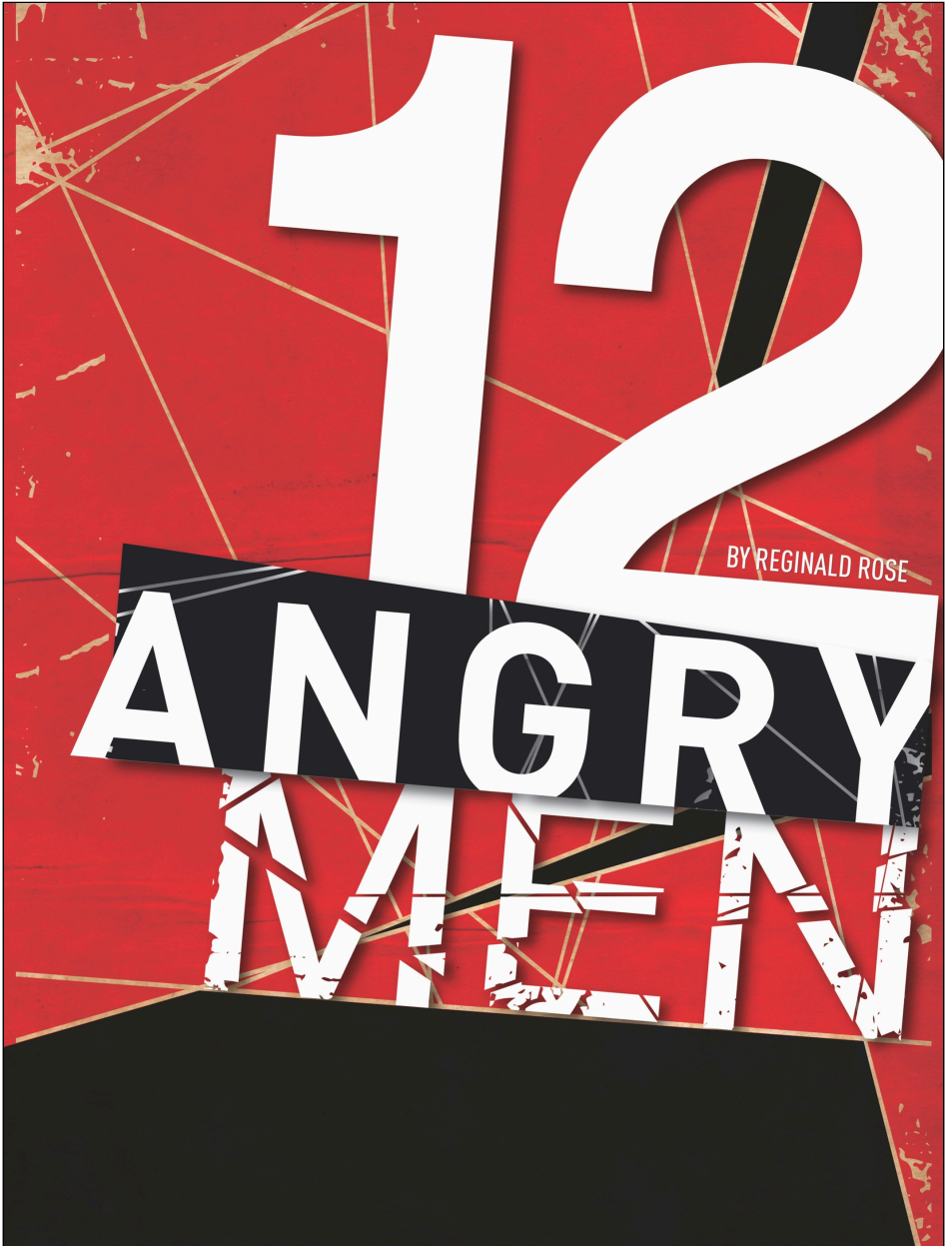

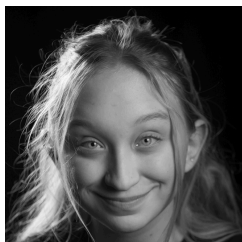

as **ONE**

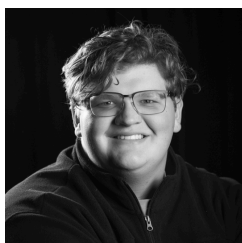

as **TWO**

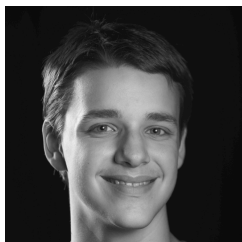

as **THREE**

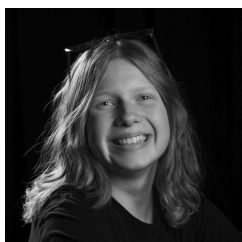

as SEVEN

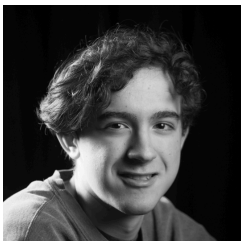

STAGE MANAGER

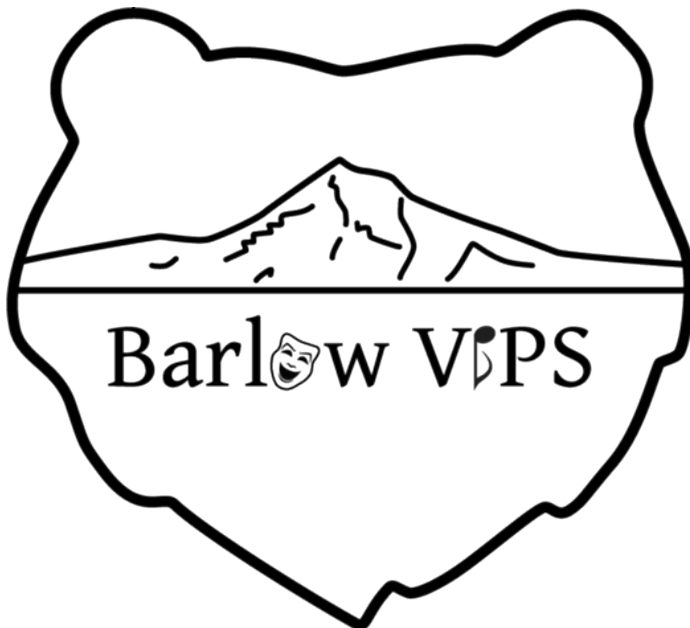

FROM THE DIRECTOR

This classic courtroom drama presents a powerful exploration of justice, prejudice, and the human condition. As you watch our cast bring these characters to life, I invite you to consider the themes and questions that lie at the heart of the play.

12 Angry Men challenges us to examine our understanding of justice and the legal system. Each juror brings their own biases, experiences, and perspectives into the deliberation room, shaping their interpretation of the evidence and the defendant's guilt or innocence. As you follow their deliberations, consider how your own biases may influence your perceptions of truth and justice.

One of the most compelling aspects of this play is the diversity of perspectives represented among the jurors. From the outset, tensions arise as jurors clash over their interpretations of the evidence and their personal biases. Please pay attention to how each juror's background, beliefs, and experiences inform their views, and reflect on how our perspectives shape our understanding of the world around us.

Throughout the play, we witness the jurors grapple with their prejudices and stereotypes, particularly about the defendant's race and socioeconomic background. As you watch their interactions unfold, consider how prejudice can cloud our judgment and prevent us from seeing the truth. Reflect on the role that empathy, compassion, and open-mindedness play in overcoming prejudice and fostering understanding.

At its core, *12 Angry Men* is a story about people - flawed, complex, and inherently human. As the jurors wrestle with their own biases and beliefs, they are forced to confront uncomfortable truths about themselves and their society. Through their interactions, we are reminded of the importance of empathy, humility, and the willingness to question our assumptions. I encourage you to connect with the characters on a human level and to consider how their struggles and triumphs resonate with your own experiences.

Thank you for joining us on this thought-provoking journey. I hope you will be inspired to engage in meaningful conversations about justice, empathy, and the power of perspective.
